Dear Friends,

The two readings, Old Testament Leviticus 19:1-2, 15-18 and the Gospel of Matthew 22:34-46 provide a guide to holiness.

Most of us are very familiar with the two great commandments from Jesus, to love God with all your heart and to love your neighbor as yourself. These two commandments are the bedrock of Christianity. As Christians, however, we don't have the corner on the market for loving God and neighbor. If we had been born into a practicing Jewish household, we would know and say the Shema prayer every day. Devout Jews know the prayer by heart: "Hear, O Israel that the Lord is our God...and you shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your might."

Although the words are the same, "love your neighbor," for Jesus their meaning is very different. In Leviticus neighbor meant *the sons of <u>your own</u> people.* When Jesus uses the word, the listeners know (from the sermon on the mount and the parable of the Good Samaritan) that neighbors are everyone, even our enemies.

Jesus continues his challenge to the Pharisees next by asking them, "what do you think of the Messiah? Whose son is he?" Their answer, the son of David, reveals that they do not understand that the Messiah is the son of God.

Love is the means to atonement and forgiveness. It is the means whereby the community of the faithful becomes restored to wholeness and reconciled to God. Something we all need to experience every day, today and tomorrow.
