Dear Friends,

"I will remember my covenant that is between me and you and every living creature of all flesh" (Genesis) These words were spoken to Noah after the flood. We read them this week in our Old Testament lesson. The readings for the first Sunday in Lent are most often focused on Satan and the power of temptation. This week I hope we can focus on something a little brighter. After all, we have been living in a most difficult year. Let us focus on something higher and brighter, 'somewhere over the rainbow'.

We all know the story of Noah's Ark from our childhood, taught in Sunday Schools and in homes with small children and little animal characters and a boat. But the story of Noah is not a child's tale. It is a story of perseverance and God's steadfastness. At the end of the sad saga of Noah's trials, God send the sign of his love, the rainbow. God says my promise is between me and you ... and all flesh – all flesh – everyone. Then God sent us the rainbow as the symbol of this covenant. Today we can look up into the sky and see that rainbow.

The rainbow is a symbol for every living creature – all flesh. When the LGBTQ community adopted the rainbow as its symbol, it acknowledged the universal truth of God's unwavering care and love for all of us – all of us.

"Somewhere Over the Rainbow" – Some of us can probably hear the childlike voice of Judy Garland singing this popular modern song or the silky melo tenor voice of IZ soothing us with the beautiful image of the rainbow.
