I will be away for the Saturday Compline and Sunday Eucharist on August 21 and 22. For the Zoom Compline service, I will tape my pre-sermon remarks for your viewing and to stimulate discussion.

If you were paying attention last week, July 17, I mentioned that the Gospel of Mark had somehow been altered to exclude two important miracles from the Gospels, the feeding of the 5,000 and Jesus walking on water. This week we know why the Lectionary authors did this. They wanted to include these same miracle stories as they were written in the Gospel of John! Why? We will be discussing this in our Zoom Dialogue Sermon at Compline on Saturday, July 24.
