The Word of the Lord comes to Abram in Genesis 15:1-6. Abram would be called Abraham and his wife Sarah would become pregnant, through the will of God, while they were both advanced in age and passed the years of childbirth. This would happen so that Abraham would not have as his only heir, a son, by a slave woman. The Lord says to count the number of the stars in the sky if he can and this will be the number of his descendants.

The Epistle is Hebrews 11:1-3, 8-16. Here we learn that 'Faith is the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen.' The remainder of the Lesson speaks to all that has been done on Faith alone. This is not just an educational lesson. It is full of meaning.

Our Gospel is Luke 12:32-40. Here Jesus teaches that his disciples must also be ready (as the Master comes home in the middle of the night), for the Son of Man is coming at an unexpected hour.
