"Do not put yourself forward in the King's presence or stand in the place of the great; for it is better to be told, "Come up here," than to be put lower in the presence of the noble (Proverbs)."

"Let mutual love continue. Do not neglect to show hospitality to strangers, for by doing that some have entertained angels without knowing it (Hebrews)."

"But when you give a banquet, invite the poor, the crippled, the lame and the blind. And you will be blessed, because they cannot repay you, for you will be repaid at the resurrection of the righteous (Luke)."
