Lent can be a very busy time. Our Shrove Tuesday potluck feast had it all--gumbo, jambalaya, onion pizza pie, sweet potatoes, soup and more! Jon burned last year's palms to be used for Ash Wednesday. There is nothing like a robust fire on a dark and cool night.

Our Ash Wednesday service on Feb. 14 was subdued as we enter 40 days of fasting and reflection that will ultimately lead to the triumphant entry and Crucifixion of our Lord Jesus Christ. For Lent, purple is the dominant color, representing repentance and Passion. Crosses are shrouded in purple and the shiny altar elements are replaced with ceramic ones.

After the Sunday service on Feb. 18, a short fellowship hour was followed by an Adult Formation Lenten program organized by Fr. Jon. It was informative and offered time for questions and discussion.
