- Bishop Julia Whitworth has announced our new **regional canon for Central Region: The Rev. Marissa S. Rohrbach** who will begin her new ministry by mid-March. The <u>Central Region</u> comprises the 60 congregations and other church-related institutions in the Boston Harbor, Alewife, Charles River and Neponset River deaneries. Emmanuel is an active member of the Neponset River deanery.
